Molly Schweers is the Public Outreach and Education Coordinator for Lee County Solid Waste.

She is a self-professed "trash nerd" and award-winning public relations professional. Ms. Schweers is passionate about spreading awareness of the importance of solid waste management to a community's overall quality of life.

Molly has a Bachelor of Science in Horticulture from New Mexico State University and a Master of Public Administration from Florida Gulf Coast University. A native New Mexican, she and her husband have lived in Fort Myers for fifteen years and have two grown children.

Lee County residents recycle about 85,000 tons of material annually. We have been in the top of recycling counties of Florida every year since 2002 and are usually in the top 5.

Of the 85,000 tons of material people put in their recycle carts, about 14,000 tons (16%) is residue (Trash).

The residue costs over \$400,000 to dispose of that is money that could otherwise be used to improve the system and keep rates down.

Improper recycling costs us all money.
