Speaker for November

Rachel Rainbolt is the Development & Education Manager for the Clinic for the Rehabilitation of Wildlife, Inc. (CROW) on Sanibel Island. Born and raised in Lee County, she is a Certified Interpretive Guide through the National Association for Interpretation and promotes community partnerships with local groups and agencies to support the long-term conservation of Southwest Florida.

CROW, the Clinic for Rehabilitation of Wildlife is located at 3883 Sanibel Captiva Road, Sanibel FL. Crow was established in 1968, and is one of the nation's leading wildlife rehabilitation hospitals for Florida's native and migratory wildlife. CROW operates a 4800 square foot hospital on 12.5 acres. They care for between 3500 and 4000 animals a year. Less than 20% come from Sanibel. CROW is the only licensed sea turtle place between Sarasota and Key West. 60% of the animals rescued are birds, 30% mammals and 10% reptiles and amphibians. They do over 2000 anesthetics a year for surgery.



Woman **Of** Interest

Donna Strickland **Nobel Laureate**

Donna Strickland, winner of 2018 Nobel Prize in Physics, is an associate professor of physics and astronomy at the University of Waterloo Ontario, Canada and former president of the Optical Society.

Strickland shared the award with Gérard Mourou and Arthur Ashkin for their work on pulse lasers - widely viewed as a precursor to precise machining and laser surgery.

Strickland becomes only the third woman in history to win the physics prize, and the only living female physics laureate.
